Leader's Guide: Bi18-3

Lecture time: 60 min.
Discussion time: approx. 30 min.

Leader's Oral Opening Comments

- Alright — let us all pull out our keys. OK- what do these little insignificant things accomplish? Amazing isn't it? Each key opens a whole new variety of possibilities and activities — think of starting a car. Right now we intend to explore a "Divine" key.

Leader's Oral Closing Comments

- A few small keys control our lives — they open a whole world to us — let this "Divine" key do that to you today.

Discussion instructions

- Minimally provide 30 minutes

Prayer instructions

- At the end of the lecture ask all your students to divide into pairs (as referred to in the lecture) and ask each other whether each of them is a servant. Then invite everyone to finish this lecture with prayer.
- For the Prayer Time have the group pray through the 4 items mentioned on the practical assignment. Prayers may be repeated. This can be done at random, or you may call out an item and let the group pray about that; then when they are finished call out a second item.
- For the private prayer time afterwards have the same 2 men who paired off after the lecture meet once more and share and pray about their new insights at the end of the day.

Pass-out material — instructions

- Make sure each person has the assignment clearly in written form at a handy place — like inside their Bible.

Practical assignments

- At your next Meeting take time for discussion of this assignment and time to pray and praise!
