

# CONDUCTING YOUR OWN WORKSHOP

## *Leader's Guide:* LP1-3

Lecture time: 45 min.

Discussion time: approx. 30 min.

### **Lecture handling instructions**

- All New Life for Churches lectures, sessions, meetings and seminars are based upon the WORKSHOP principle. That is each meeting consists of: a) a lecture, b) student participation time in discussion and prayer, c) practical assignments (, i.e. applications at home), and d) accountability of blessings/results at the next session. Therefore in this lecture the word "WORKSHOP" is used.
- Following the small group discussion time, take one hour to make a WORKSHOP plan. Have each student make his own plan — write in names, locations, titles, etc. You guide this activity and lead them orally point by point using the lecture outline.

### **Leader's Oral Opening Comments**

- *"Making Other People Successful"* — Brothers here is your chance.

### **Leader's Oral Closing Comments**

- *"Making Other People Successful"* — it's God idea — Are you in? Can the Lord count on you? Can the church count on you? Can I count on you?

### **Discussion instructions**

#### **Prayer instructions**

- Let them pray over the plans they have just made with one partner.

### **Pass-out material instructions**

- Prepare a lecture outline for each attendee.
- Pass out practical assignments

### **Practical assignments**

- Discuss practical assignment and have participants set dates — be goal-oriented!
- Follow up during your next WORKSHOP. Follow-up guarantees the value of what you are doing. People respond to what you **inspect**, not to what you *expect*.
