Leader's Oral Opening Comments

This lecture clearly illustrates one of the key ingredients of a good leader, i.e. to learn obedience. A great leader obeys his superiors or other higher power. A great leader listens and often follows — obeys — suggestions from his co-workers or team of assistants. A great leader values advice, seeks it and then often uses —obeys — it. A great Christian man frequently learns from his dear wife, accepts her advice and does — obeys — it. But above all he learns to obey His Master the Holy Spirit.

Leader's Oral Closing Comments

- What a unique and in-depth way to develop 'obedience'.
- > Let us really discuss this in-depth.

Discussion instructions

Again and again stop the discussion to ask for and let someone confess their lack of obedience.

Leaders are strong people, obedience is often their weakness.

Obeying those under them, those lower than them, - helpers - is often NOT practiced.

Prayer instructions

Break-up the discussions very frequently and have one person lead a prayer about that specific topic they are discussing at the moment. Then let them proceed to another topic and stop and pray again, and — again, and — again.
