

In time most of the practical items presented should also be passed on to others.

For you as leader probably the top quality next to PRAYER is faithfulness. Faithfulness conquers almost all obstacles and is the quality the Creator God your Father uses to do over and above that which you can presently think or imagine. The core of faithfulness rests in obedience to the guidelines. Not blindly following them, but interpreting and applying them, and by so doing improving them so others can benefit from your service for Jesus. We hope you will help us to do better for others yet to come. Thank you, and by so doing may you experience the JOY of our Father in an overflowing way.

This Template is ONLY a suggested guide.

It is composed of Quarterly Reports – Weekly Report. – Daily Reports.

- Quarterly Reports need to be weekly reviewed / updated and aligned with your annual Vision. By so doing the quarterly report will streamline your total ministry.

These reports are not only intended to guide, but also enable you to assist the many folks your Father God has placed in your hands for eternal values.

Much of this is for yourself.

Much is to be mutually shared with the precious wife of your youth.

Some is to be used by your team and others.

A special place has been provided to allow for your wife's own prayerful considerations.

GETTING READY PERSONALLY

***A Leader needs to be RENEWED / refreshed by supernatural POWER
This is God's business – it is God's desire – it is God's plan.***

Many outstanding spiritual leaders have discovered ways to remain exactly in the center of God's will. Many discovered spending 15 minutes a day in quiet meditation/calm waiting on God. Then spending 1 hour per week doing that. And later once a month spending 1 day just quietly waiting on the Triune God, kept them in sweet heavenly communion. The intimate secret of really knowing Him, His ways and His desires. They experienced God's power flow through the principle of giving time to God Himself.

Their simple formula is:

Daily: rest and meditate 15 minutes.

Weekly: rest and meditate 1 hour.

Monthly: rest and meditate 1 day (minimally 6 hours)

Dreaming your Dreams

Giving time to God for 15 minutes, 1 hour or a whole day is to give **GOD** priority. The key point is to enjoy your Father God the Creator. Do you have the capacity to actually enjoy Him? Take time to be at rest– to be available – to be open– to listen. It is NOT a day of prayer – not a day to bring request or share plans. Not a day to do a lot of talking to Him.

Ingredients may be: rest – daydream – enjoy – quietly find out where you are at – who are you really? Thankfulness for Jesus the Redeemer, appreciation of the Holy Spirit Power-flow, praise for your Father the Creator God, should be your overriding element. Your whole time whether – 15 min, 1 hour or a whole day should be filled with whatever is noble, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is admirable, and whatever is true. If anything is excellent or praiseworthy—think about such things. And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.

THOUGHTS ABOUT GIVING TIME DIRECTLY TO GOD

Being Renewed!

God rested ... if we don't take a day of rest, our actions say *we think we are better* than God!

Every leader wants to be pure – holy – powerful – effective - fruitful.

But actually God wants to make us holy; God is waiting to make us holy, God has a plan to make us holy.

Jesus emphasized rest for our souls even amidst busy times.

In this context check out **Ex 33: 14, Matt 11:28, Mark 6:31, and Heb 4:1**. Read!

So God has a definite desire, God has a definite plan.

God's system for purity – holiness – powerfulness – effectiveness – fruitfulness is extremely simple. God's says "If you give me time, I will give you inner rest – inner renewal" (all these good features of this special quality)

God has spoken ***"give one full day of rest and I will bless you abundantly"***.

It is really meant to be a reminder that God is first. And to remind us of our limitations, even Christ Himself stepped back from ministry to rest.

By withdrawing from our worldly activities and concerns, we give priority to God and His way of doing things.

The *REST* principle is one of the strongest in Scripture, and it almost seems like God is telling us "If you give me one hour of physical, emotional, mental, and spiritual rest and worship I will give you one hour of holiness – powerfulness – effectiveness – fruitfulness.

God, for optimum performance, simply designed for mankind to have a rest, physically, emotionally and for your *souls*..

For your own blessings read the following verses and see that God himself will make you holy and spiritually successful. He will make you like a king riding far above your earthly difficulties.

The LORD commanded Moses to tell the people of Israel, "Keep the Sabbath, my day of rest, because it is a sign between you and me for all time to come, to show that I, the LORD, have made you my own people. You must keep the day of rest, because it is sacred. Exo 31:12-14a I will bless those who always observe the Sabbath and do not misuse it. Isa 56:2a

The LORD says, "If you treat the Sabbath as sacred and do not pursue your own interests on that day; if you value my holy day and honor it by not traveling, working, or talking idly on that day, then you will find the joy that comes from serving me. GROWING 12 MEN for God

Blessings mean growth. Growth means more work. More work requires participants / leaders. Every leader must eventually pas-on his leadership. No successor means no success. New leaders/successors must be prepared for a growing ministry. Jesus set the example by preparing 12 ordinary men for spiritual leadership. As we change through the process of aging our ministries also change. With each change, or illness, or relocation another man needs to fill in where we left off. This is the continuous challenge to yearly grow new successful leaders. Growing one man, then another, and later another, one step at a time will produce a lifetime of fruitful servant leaders. Eventually 12 such protégées will provide your ministry with a crown of glory.

The CoH Weekly Ministry Plan

CoH WEEKLY PLAN – Friday is review & prepare.

Friday is the leader's Prayerful Spiritual Inventory Task.

- A leader may choose to do this with 3 or 4 key assistants.

- As a CoH grows more co-leaders, key assistants, and helpers should be involved in this process.

a) Weekly the leader analyzes the past week's spiritual happenings.

- Reports need to be submitted by helpers – what they did – how they did it – fruitfulness.
 - He marks the completed weekly chart with red plusses for all activities successfully accomplished.

b) Weekly the leader prepares the next Weekly activities.

- Items need to be bought or ordered or prepared.
- Tasks need to be assigned & explained to helpers.
- Training sessions for helpers need to be clarified and agreed upon.

c) Weekly the leader stream-lines the activities to match the CoH monthly Plan.

- He verifies the activities done – and to be done – with the CoH Monthly Calendar.
- He focusses on the monthly goals.
- He adjusts the weekly plan / activities so their fruitfulness will accomplish the monthly CoH plan.

d) Weekly the leader carries out an in-depth spiritual survey of the CoH people, team, believers, and unchurched.

- Where are they at now? Where were they at before? Where are they going?
- People have changed, are changing, growing, becoming more like Jesus.
- What do they need? Encouragement? A personal phone call with prayer? A personal visit?
- Who and how would be the best person to show love, mercy, and produce joy into that person?
- How will all that be reflected on the next Weekly Plan and Monthly Calendar?

Perhaps you received your own personal calling – perhaps your calling came in dual form upon both you and your husband – or perhaps your solid marital union provided that call for you.

In any case true genuine marital partnership comes out of a bondage by which according to Christ's own word male and female become one in flesh, in emotions, in character, in spirit, in outlook, in desire, in vision, in serving your Father God the Creator. You are part of this universal God-system to beatify souls to enhance eternity forever. It is both a great responsibility and a great privilege. Many ladies have not received such privilege as you do.

Peruse and discover in which we you can be the helper for your husband and his tasks for which God created him. As iron sharpens iron/your husband is the task Jesus expects you to fulfill. You are that instrument through prayer and the Holy Spirit to accomplish that which is above and beyond your own and your husband's present imagination. It is a glorious task – a task for which you were specifically created and designed. Daily PRAISE and ENJOY your journey.

GETTING READY PERSONALLY

***YOU as the Leader's wife need to be RENEWED / refreshed by supernatural POWER
This is God's business – it is God's desire – it is God's plan.***

Many outstanding spiritual leaders have discovered ways to remain exactly in the center of God's will. Many discovered spending 15 minutes a day in quiet meditation/dreamlike waiting on God. Then spending 1-hour per week doing that. And later once a month spending 1-day just quietly waiting on the Triune God kept them in sweet heavenly communion. The intimate secret of really knowing Him, His ways and His desires. They experienced God's power flow through the principle of giving time to God Himself.

Their simple formula is:

Daily: rest and meditate 15-minutes.

Weekly: rest and meditate 1-hour.

Monthly: rest and meditate 1-day (minimally 6 hours)

Dreaming your Dreams

Giving time to God for 15 minutes, 1-hour or a whole is to give **GOD** priority. The key point is to enjoy your Father God the Creator. Do you have the capacity to actually enjoy Him? Take time to be at rest– to be available – to be open– to listen. It is NOT a day of prayer – not a day to bring request or share plans. Not a day to do a lot of talking to Him.

Ingredients may be: rest – daydream – enjoy – quietly find out where you are at – who are you really? Thankfulness for Jesus the Redeemer, appreciation of the Holy Spirit Power-flow, praise for your Father the Creator God, should be your overriding element. Your whole time whether – 15 min – 1-hour or a whole day should be filled with whatever is noble, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is admirable, and whatever is true. If anything is excellent or praiseworthy—think about such things. And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.

Being Renewed!

God rested ... if we don't take a day of rest, our actions say *we think we are better* than God!

Every leader wants to be pure – holy – powerful – effective - fruitful.

But actually God wants to make us holy; God is waiting to make us holy, God has a plan to make us holy.

Jesus emphasized rest for our souls even amidst busy times.

In this context check out **Ex 33: 14, Matt 11:28, Mark 6:31, and Heb 4:1**. Read!

So God has a definite desire, God has a definite plan.

God's system for purity – holiness – powerfulness – effectiveness – fruitfulness is extremely simple. God's says "if you give me time, I will give you inner rest – inner renewal" (all these good features of this special quality)

God has spoken ***"give one full day of rest and I will bless you abundantly"***.

It is rather meant to be a reminder that God is first. And to remind us of our limitations, even Christ would step back from ministry to rest.

By withdrawing from our worldly activities and concerns, we give priority to God and His way of doing things.

The *REST* principle is one of the strongest in Scripture, and it almost seems like God is telling us "if you give me one hour of physical, emotional, mental, and spiritual rest and worship I will give you one hour of holiness – powerfulness – effectiveness – fruitfulness.

God, for optimum performance simply designed for mankind to have a rest, physically, emotionally and for your *souls*..

For your own blessings read the following verses and see that God himself will make you holy and spiritually successful. He will make you like a king riding far above your earthly difficulties.

Measuring the woman

Rather it means unbiasedly evaluating his ingredients like; character, temperament, heartbeat, spirituality, prayer life, personal holiness, emotional status, relationships, financial attitude, family intimateness, quality of workmanship, vision, passion, aggressiveness.

Phil 4:8 Brothers {sisters} , whatever is true, whatever is noble, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is admirable—if anything is excellent or praiseworthy—think about such things.

This is about developing Spiritual eyes – Seeing actual **mini-miracles**. A miracle is a surprise happening that has no simple explanation. It is seeing Jesus do things. It is NOT an answer to prayer – {possible exceptions}. Mostly these should be physical phenomenon. Such physical happenings are tremendous powerful stories for unbelievers.
